### **Tax claimed by Suffolk Advanced Motorcyclists (SAM)**

- SAM will reclaim 28p of tax on every £1 you gave up to 5 April 2008.
- SAM will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 you give on or after 6 April 2008.
- The Government will pay SAM an additional 3p on every £1 you give between 6 April 2008 and 5 April 2012. This transitional relief for SAM does not affect your personal tax position.

*For example on a Full Member renewal of £20, SAM would claim back £5.60 being made up of £5 tax and an additional £0.60 from the Government.*

### **If you pay income tax at the higher rate**

You must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self Assessment tax return if you want to receive the additional tax relief due to you.
